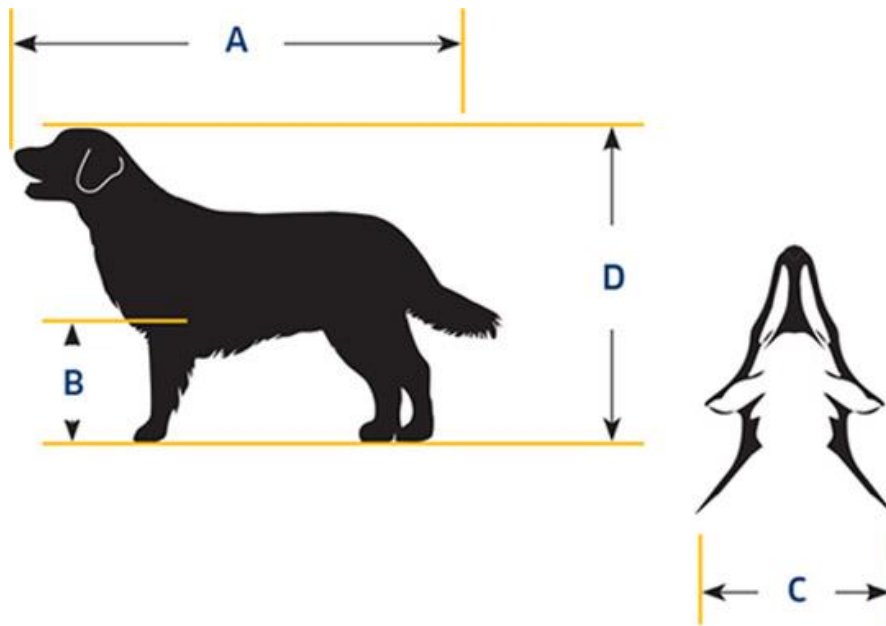


How to measure your pet



Kennel sizing chart for dogs and cats

A = Length of animal from nose to root of tail

B = Height from ground to elbow joint

C = Width across shoulders

D = Height of animal in a natural standing position from the top of the head, hair poof (poodles) or the ear tip, whichever is higher. Note: your pet's head or ear tips, whichever is higher, must not touch the top of the crate. There should be 3" of clearances inside the kennel above the highest point of the pet.

How to determine kennel size

Length = $A + B$

Width = $C \times 2$

Height = $D + 3''$

For travel to and from all destinations and for short-nosed dogs: use a crate one size larger than normal
